Providing out-of-school time care to students in grades K-8 before and after school, on holiday breaks, in-service days and during summer break

Students enrolled AT HOST are provided with:

- Homework assistance and mentoring, daily nutritious meals and age appropriate enrichment
- Curricula that includes weekly lesson plans, themes and individualized student goals
- Classrooms staffed by professional educators with Bachelor's degrees in Education or a related field or a Child Development Associate (CDA)

Our program is:

- Member of the Pennsylvania Child Care Association (PACCA)
- Affiliated with National Institute on Out of School Time (NIOST), the National Afterschool Association (NAA), Allegheny Partners for Outof-School time (APOST), and FitUnited
- Licensed by Department of Human Services (DHS)



Transportation and Child Care Fees:

Transportation between HOST and school is provided during the school year through Woodland Hills School District for families who live in the district. HOST accepts child care subsidies to ensure care is available for all eligible families. Private pay rates vary based on schedule.
